REFUGEE SUPPORT \$750,998

- 113 refugees seeking asylum from 11 countries were resettled in our communities and are receiving on-going assistance.

HOSPICE \$2,339,777

- 225 patients and families received compassionate care as they faced end of life issues.

TURNSTYLES \$236,241

- Community thrift store that accepts and distributes in-kind donations.

COUNSELING \$1,398,816

- 8600 elementary school students received support from Catholic Charities school counselors.
- Nearly 12,000 individuals and families received mental health counseling.

EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE \$2,516,912

- Over \$1 million in contributed food helped to feed nearly 25,000 individuals.
- 3300 households received assistance with rent, utilities and prescriptions.

FAMILIES & CHILDREN \$3,370,363

- 1000 hours of pregnancy counseling and 9 babies placed for adoption.
- Over 100 infants, toddlers and pre-schoolers received nationally accredited early childhood care and education.
- 16 teen moms in the New Directions for Teen Parents program graduated from high school.
- Over 90 children, including those with special needs, received loving care in Catholic Charities' foster homes.
